The family of Lisa Marie Young will hold a candlelight vigil for the missing 21 year-old on Sunday, 8:30 p.m., at Swy-A-Lana Lagoon.

Young was last seen leaving a downtown nightclub on Canada Day weekend and an extensive police search has so far failed to locate her.

Joanne Young, Lisa's mother, said the vigil is in support of a renewed police effort to find the young
